As population matures or shifts with the District, certain buildings and campuses or sites may no longer be needed and should be recycled or sold for the benefit of the public which originally acquired the property. In determining which facility or site is to be retired from school purposes, the district will be guided by a combination of factors including, but not limited to, the following:

1. Educational Flexibility - Which school facility is least acceptable for housing a modern and flexible educational program?
2. Neighborhood - Which building is most isolated in terms of proximity to the residences of the students?
3. Cost - Which school building represents the highest cost in terms of upkeep and maintenance and in terms of allowing for the operation of an instructional program comparable with other instructional programs of the district?

The District may seek both professional advice and input from the community in making the final determination as to the retirement of any school facility or site.
